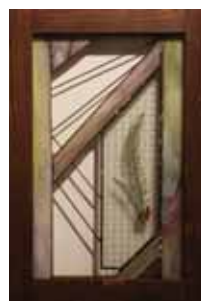

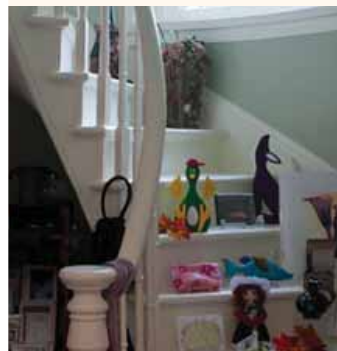

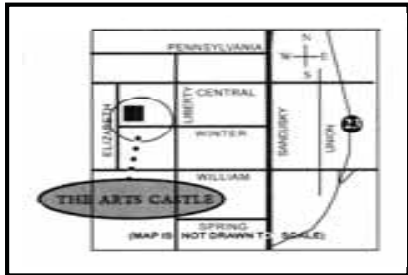
Schools may be closed but we may be open (or vice versa.) Check to be sure.
